Dear colleagues!

The Institute of Forest of the NAS of Belarus and the Young Scientists Council are invited you to take part in the International school-conference of young scientists "Forest science, youth, future", which is scheduled to take place at Gomel from 26 to 30 June 2017. Undergraduates, post graduate students, experts and young scientists are invited to participate in it. **Age limit** – **35** *years* (*including*).

The general purpose of International school-conference for young scientists "Forest science, youth, future" to involve of graduate and undergraduate students, specialists and young scientists into discussion on urgent scientific problems and innovations in forestry, increase their qualification, develop the creative scientific communications between generations of scientists and integration with foreign specialists.

Main scientific areas of the school-conference:

- forest science, forestry, forest management and forest inventory;
- forest tree breeding, seed production, genetics and biotechnology;

- reforestation, nursery technologies;
- forest protection;
- biology and ecology of forest, forest radioecology, bioenergetics;
- non timber production, ecotourism and game managment;
- forest park management, landscape architecture;
- forest education and reserve area activity;
- interdisciplinary forest research.

Languages: Belarusian, Russian, English.

Types of participation: Lectures (invited lectures for participants will be given by leading scientists). **Oral session** (*include only previously selected by the Organizing committee presentations of participants*). **Poster session**. **Correspondence participation** (will be provided too).

Excursions, educational and field sessions to Korenevskaya forest research enterprise of the Institute of Forest of the NAS of Belarus and several forest enterprises of the Ministry of Forestry will be organized. Detailed agenda of the school-conference will be provided in the 3rd information letter.

Conference registration fee

The planned amount of the organizational fee is 30 Belarusian rubles, or 15 US dollars. The payment of the organizational fee, the cost of which includes the costs of the school-conference, is carried out during registration in Belarusian rubles. Participants of the school-conference will assume all accumulated costs for accommodation, meals and travelling.

Publication requirements:

Article up to 4 pages must be sent to Organizing Committee e-mail address forestschool2017@mail.ru not later than May 22, 2017. The conference materials will be published before the conference and posted on the school-conference website of the Institute of Forest of the NAS of Belarus. Publication in conference materials is free. The Organizing Committee will not distribute materials. The conference materials can be picked up on-site, and the files will be emailed.

Materials with a volume of no more than 4 pages of A4 format, document Microsoft Word (2003/2007/2010); Times New Roman; font size 14 pt; line spacing – single; indent paragraph – 1.0 cm; fields: left – 3 cm, right – 1.5 cm, top and lower – 2 cm. Text width alignment, without transferring the words. Pages are not numbered. The Latin names of species are italicized. The abbreviations should be deciphered in the text.

In the upper left corner the UDC cipher is placed (font -12 pt).

On the next line, the title of the report is specified by CAPITAL LETTERS, **boldface**, 14 pt, centered. Then we use lowercase letters: in the next line – the author(s) (a surname, initials), **boldface**, 14 pt, centered; in the next line – place of employment, the city, the country, *italic*, 12 pt, centered; in the next line – the e-mail address, italic, 12 pt, centered. If authors from different organizations, the number of the organization on the list is put after the author's surname and initials.

The summary (5-10 lines) begins after an empty line -italic, 12 pt, on width. The main text begins after an empty line.

The graphs, the figures (JPEG, resolution not lower than 300 dpi) should be mounted in text, black and white, with possibility of editing.

The formulas should be typed in the Formula Editor MathType with a full decoding of all the notations in the text.

At the end of the article the list of references is placed (LITERATURE, centered, begins after an empty line), in order of appearance in the text. References to the literature in the text are indicated by numbers in square brackets.

No scientific or technical editing of abstract will be done.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject the requirement or thematic irrelevant submissions. In this case, authors will be informed by the Organizing Committee
